website for comprehensive information on all the areas we cover.





# COMMUNITY ARABIC PROGRAM



The Community Arabic Language Program was created to introduce expat community members at KAUST to the rich Arabic language and the culture of Saudi Arabia. The program caters to adult learners, offering introductory levels that are gradually upgraded to intermediate and advanced levels, based on the students' requirements.

In response to parents' demands, the Arabic Program for Kids was introduced. Initially, the program combined non-native Arabic kids with kids who came from Arabic backgrounds. However, two separate sections were eventually

created: one for non-native Arabic kids and one for native Arabic kids who require more emphasis on Arabic reading and writing skills.

There is also a group of advanced-level students who wanted additional practice to further improve their Arabic language skills. To meet their requirements, the Arabic Language Café was introduced. The Arabic Café sessions take place outside of the classroom environment, with each session having a dedicated theme. Last year's theme focused on building up conversation skills, and this year's theme is focused on story reading.

All the programs have seen a growing interest from the community, with a sharp increase in the number of students in the past two years compared to previous years.

We plan to continue offering these programs and help the KAUST community learn Arabic, promoting crosscultural understanding and communication.

Over 40 skilled men and women, aged 16 and above, gathered



the national governing body overseeing all aspects of rock climbing and hiking in Saudi Arabia. This partnership was forged with the aim of promoting and developing the sport of climbing on a national scale.

The daycare provides child care services for infants as young as two months old up to children aged three and a half years. As part of the program, they help prepare children for the transition to kindergarten by teaching them important life skills.

This involves teaching children self-care skills such as dressing, feeding, and cleaning up after

themselves, enabling them to become self-reliant and confident. While some children may be more ready than others, the carefully designed program ensures that most children are well-prepared for kindergarten.

To celebrate this important milestone, the daycare holds a graduation ceremony prior to the children leaving for kindergarten and to grade 1.

Parents and family are invited to participate and cheer for the children. Each child is called to the stage in their gown to receive their graduation certificate while a photo of the child and their name is displayed on the screen.

## THE FAMILY AND CHILD SUPPORT CENTER (FCSC) **USING EVIDENCE BASED PROGRAMS TO** PROVIDE THERAPEUTIC SUPPORT

The Family and Child Support Center (FCSC) opened in KAUST in October 2023 and is in Gardens beside the main TKS campus. It is truly a communityled initiative envisaged by parents and supported by KAUST leadership, advocating for additional support for their children's language, academic, social and emotional needs.

The FCSC is managed by KAUST Health with a remit to support the language, motor, emotional, and academic development of children and young people aged 18 months to 18 years; with a

special regard for the health and wellness of neurodiverse children and families in KAUST.

"In less than twelve months, the FCSC team working alongside parents and critical stakeholders in TKS, TKS Enrichment Office, Daycare, and KAUST Health have taken an idea and made it a reality.

I have no doubt as we complete one year of service and move to develop further in year two that allow parents and children the Center will go from strength to strength and be a beacon of excellence for those children who require access to support and the families around them.",

### CREATING STRATEGIC LINKS WITHIN THE KINGDOM

Service offerings have been enhanced to include a Speech and Language Therapist, Occupational Therapist and Clinical Psychologist on the team. This multi-disciplinary team now provides holistic support, focusing on early intervention.

In its first year, the FCSC introduced innovative programs to KAUST for the first time. These included PEERS© (a social skills program), Sensory Circuits (a motor skills program), Floreo™, Ovation™ (Virtual Reality programs), and PACT (a parent-led, play-based

Since last October, our team has facilitated over 500 hours of intervention by administering comprehensive assessments and over 60 individual consultations.

An activity program for the Center to maximize outreach to the KAUST community by creating venues that to exchange views and experiences within a fun, informative setting has been created.

**Activities and interventions** are available to all children at KAUST, regardless of their level of need.

autism intervention). We also ran a Parenting Course (Love and Logic©) and reading and writing group interventions.

#### PARENT VOLUNTEER COMMITTEE

Central to the work of the FCSC is the Parent Volunteer Committee. They run monthly family socials, organize dyslexia and autism awareness weeks at KAUST, and help establish research partnerships within KAUST, the Kingdom, and internationally. For parents, having a Center like the FCSC can be a lifeline.

Professor Ahmed Eltawil of CEMSE (Computer, Electrical, and Mathematical Sciences and Engineering) and

Mai Beshady, Chair of the parent committee at FCSC, comments that the FCSC is slated to become a pillar of the KAUST community that brings people together with the goal to support and nurture our children and each other, "It is truly a testament to the uniqueness of the KAUST community. The impact of the Center within KAUST has been phenomenal from day one and will have a far-reaching impact on the lives of many within KAUST and beyond."

According to Dr. Paul O'Callaghan, the FCSC Clinical Lead, it is this combination of clinical expertise and parentto-parent support that makes the FCSC so unique, "Parents are the true experts on their children. The FCSC began as a parent-led initiative of parents advocating for the children, and it is this parent engagement that will be the bedrock of the success of the FCSC."



The KAUST Pop-up Souk is a shortterm space for shops, activities, and programs that was introduced by the Retail team to create a partnership with vendors outside KAUST. The aim is to host selected stores that offer products required by the KAUST community residents for limited periods.

The retail services team carefully plans according to the different needs of the KAUST community, such as a watersports store during summer, a stationary store before the back-to-school period, and a flower store around Mother's Day.

The project has been a great success, with the Pop-Up Souk being operational for 288 days, a +600% increase compared to the previous period. Over 15 varied shops were featured, including electronics, carpets and a pet

The team looks forward to hosting more exciting pop-up shops catering to the KAUST community's diverse needs.


